On Monday, June 10th, 2024, The Farmersville Village Council met in regular session. Mayor Nick Lamb called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and followed by roll call.

Mr. Cunningham moved, Ms. Hadley seconded to approve the meeting minutes of May 28th, 2024. Roll Call: Mr. Cunningham; yes, Ms. Hadley; yes, Mr. Craig; yes. MOTION PASSED.

Mr. Cunningham moved, Ms. Hadley seconded to approve the bills for this period 93-104-2024 and warrants 37390-37408 totaling \$29,756.16. Roll Call: Mr. Cunningham; yes, Ms. Hadley; yes, Mr. Craig; yes. MOTION PASSED.

POLICE DEPARTMENT COMMENTS: Chief Bruner requested to have the no parking area near stop signs painted yellow, so the "no parking area" can be better enforced. Mr. Shell said he will discuss this further with Chief Bruner. Chief Bruner reports the bike path leading out to the park needs repairs. Mr. Shell said he will discuss the repairs with the township.

FIRE ASSOCIATION COMMENTS: Chief Erisman announced he picked up the new medic. He reports it will be in service by the end of June.

LAW DIRECTOR COMMENTS: none

MAYOR COMMENTS: Mayor Lamb announced The Grounds Coffehouse will have their soft opening this week, followed by a ribbon cutting ceremony on June 14th, 2024. Mayor Lamb reported the first meeting to discuss strategic planning for the Village took place prior to the meeting.

VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR REPORT: Mr. Shell reports work on Elm St begins this week. Wagner Paving estimated cost is \$72,000. Mr. Shell reports the Village will use \$50,000 of permissive tax money to help cover the cost. Mr. Shell reports the striping for Elm St. is estimated to cost \$5000. Mr. Shell reports there was a second break on the forced sewer main along the pike. Mr. Shell reports he will meet with the construction

company and Mr. Depew on how to move forward, to avoid future breaks since this is the main sewer line coming from the new school. Mr. Lamb asked Mr. Shell to spray for weeks throughout the Village.

FISCAL OFFICERS REPORT: Ms. Marascio reports she got an official letter from the IRS stating that the civil penalty from 2018 has been reversed. Ms. Marascio reported she transferred \$100,000 from checking to Star Ohio resulting in the Star Ohio account's balance to be \$1,032,845.63 and the checking account balance to be \$142,954.94.
